**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** July 28th will include 8 hours training in the area of color guard and formation training. July 29<sup>th</sup>. 8 hours of sensory training. The student and their mount will be subjected to various types of sensory distractions often seen in day to day policing. The student will also be placed in crowd control type scenarios throughout the course. July 30th is the Horse Baton Course, providing eight hours of training in the use of the 40 inch horse baton and tactics. The objective of this course is to educate the student on the use/implementation of the 40 inch mounted horse baton. The class will consist of “hands on” training with the use of the students mount and horse baton. Lunch will be provided daily. Dinner (BBQ) offered on site Thursday night.
