COURSE DESCRIPTION:

August 13th will be 8 hours training in the area of formation riding and sensory training. The student and their mount will learn formation riding as it pertains to law enforcement activities and practice on several extreme sensory obstacles.

August 14th will be 8 hours of crowd control and sensory training. The students will be subjected to various types of sensory distractions often seen in day to day mounted policing. The student will also be placed in several crowd control and high level sensory exercises.

A meal will be provided to the attendees on both days midway through the course, as well as water and sports drinks throughout the day.
